

# **Section 1: Description**

# Description

The following information provides a functional description of the Baggage Compartment Floor Protector, Kit as defined in Alpine Aerotech LP authority dataset AAL-313-050-001.

- Due to the fact that the Bell light series of aircraft is used as often for seismic, logging, and other industrial uses, there is a potential for cargo to damage expensive composite panels located in the baggage compartment. This occurs most frequently during loading and unloading operations, but can also occur during small inflight shifts of said cargo.
- The Baggage Compartment Floor Protector, Kit when installed adds additional protection to the panel, as it is manufactured from a material specifically designed to spread and attenuate energy.

- I. Perform a Detailed Inspection on all items to ensure proper security.
- II. Perform a Detailed Inspection on all items/materials to ensure proper integrity.
- III. Perform a Detailed Inspection on the Baggage Compartment Floor Protector, Kit to ensure that it is not delaminating.
- IV. Perform a Detailed Inspection on all surfaces & locations with Velcro applied to ensure no damage has occurred to the underlying honeycomb panel.



1. Gain access to the baggage compartment floor. Reference Figure 1.





Figure 2 Some Items Removed for Clarity

- 2. Pre-fit the Panel, Assy (Item 1) by lining up the slots & oval cut outs with the footman loops & ribs mounted to the floor panel. Reference Figures 1 & 2.
- 3. With the panel lined up use the pre-cut .25 holes and a felt pen to mark out the locations for the Velcro, Details (Items 6, 7 & 8) and remove the panel (Item 1). Reference Figure 2.

- 4. Clean the areas between the felt pen marks with alcohol taking care not to wipe away the felt pen marks.
- 5. Individually separate each Velcro, Detail (Items 6, 7 & 8) off of the Floor Panel, Assy (Item 1) and peel adhesive backing from the Velcro, Details (Items 6, 7 & 8).
- 6. Using the felt pen marks as reference points, apply the Velcro, Details (Items 6, 7 & 8) to the honeycomb panel in their respective locations. Reference Figure 3. Apply adequate pressure to ensure a secure bond.





- 7. Re-install the Floor Panel, Assy (Item 1) onto Velcro strips.
- 8. Installation complete.
- 9. Perform a General Inspection of all items to ensure proper installation.
- 10. Update the aircraft logbook for the installation of the Baggage Compartment Floor Protector, Kit.

# **Removal Instructions**


- 1. The removal of the Baggage Compartment Floor Protector, Kit for either inspections, or mission configuration, can be considered the opposite of installation for step 7. For permanent removal, of the Baggage Compartment Floor Protector, Kit perform step 7 opposite of installation and remove all bonded Velcro, Details.
- 2. Perform a General Inspection of all items to ensure proper removal.
- 3. Update the aircraft logbook for the removal of the Baggage Compartment Floor Protector, Kit.


